

WHITE WINE

Les Terrasses White - Ardeche, France *VE* 175ml 5.95 / 21

The wine takes its name from the terraces – locally called “Faysses” – and their dry-stone walls reflect the history and beauty of Ardèche’s vineyards. This Grenache Blanc side of the blend brings ample stone fruit character, and Sauvignon Blanc a pronounced aromas of citrus, white flowers and a minty finish.

Pinot Grigio - Gadi, Veneto, Italy *VE* 29

Gadi is a lovely full and rich style premium Pinot Grigio with a modern presentation. Straw yellow with greenish hints; aromas of citrus fruit with more delicate scents of apple and peach that combine very well with the honey finish and typical, flavours of stone fruits, lime, lychee with a delicious long-lasting intensity.

Gavi Poderi della Collinetta - Italy *VE* 37

A bouquet of floral overtones and captivating hints of pineapple, apricot and peach; the palate is pleasingly fresh with marked apple characteristics.

Coral do Mar Albarino - Rias Biaxas, Spain *VE* 41

Intense, fruity aromas and delicate hints of flowers, highlighting the strong character, and an excellent representation of the grape – ideal for both enthusiasts and those discovering Rias Baixas.

HaHa Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand *VE* 42

A true expression of Marlborough, characterised by intense tropical and passionfruit aromatics in combination with more delicate citrus and floral notes. These attributes translate generously onto the palate, which is bursting with tropical fruit, ripe citrus and fine mineral acidity.

Chablis ‘La Pierelee’ - Burgandy, France *VE* 71

Chablis La Pierrelée meaning “the Stones” references the soils of the region and the mineral edge of classic Chablis style. The wine is fine and expressive – full of fruit when young and developing complex flavours with age. The bouquet opens-up to reveal fresh, white-fleshed fruit with a hint of spiciness. With more time, a mineral note brings complexity to the ensemble. A long aromatic persistence with a good density of fruit on the palate gives an outstanding balance.

RED WINE

Les Terrasses Grenache Merlot - France *VE* 175ml 5.95 / 21

This wine takes its name from the terraces – locally called ‘Faysses’ – and their dry-stone walls reflect the history and beauty of Ardèche’s vineyards. A beautiful ruby red colour, it offers fruity aromas such as strawberry and raspberry; very round in mouth, it is fruit-forward with polished tannins.

Tondeluna Tinto - Rioja, Spain *VE* 27

A fruity red wine expressing the characteristic liquorice flavours of Tempranillo. Unoaked, it shows bright cherry and red fruits with a soft, long finish. A fantastic Spanish red, by small family producer Vallemayor.

Woolpunda Shiraz - South Australia *VE* 31

A rich, vibrant style of Shiraz, lightly oaked with dark fruit richness and a smooth tannin structure. Delivering length and a subtle complexity, this Shiraz showcases the age and reputation of Byrnes Estate vines. Deep crimson in colour, with ripe cassis and plum aromas, accompanied by spices and subtle oak. A full-bodied palate intense with raspberry and mulberry fruits and with anise and mocha accents.

Azulejo Lisboa, Castelão, Pinot Noir - Portugal *VE* 33

Very intense and complex aromas of raspberries, cherry and wild fruits. On the palate, concentrated blackcurrant and berry fruit flavours with oak notes, well balanced and a long and pleasant finish. A lovely wine produced by the Cantos santa Lima family of Portugal.

Tucumen Reserve Malbec - Mendoza, Argentina *VE* 42

A well balanced wine between oak and fruit; a bouquet of cherry, plum and blackberry with spice notes of cinnamon and vanilla. It has a strong and elegant palate with rounded, sweet tannins. A very luxurious full-bodied Malbec by the Budeguer family.

Saint Emilion Chateau La Pointe-Bouquey - France 50

Château La Pointe Bouquey is a blend of 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Cabernet Franc, the vines have an average age of 40 years aged in French oak. A soft and well-balanced wine with aromas of red fruits, cedar wood, and vanilla; layers of fruit on the palate are rounded off by silky, already integrated, tannins.

ROSE WINE

Pinot Grigio Serarossa Blush - Veneto, Italy *VE* 23

A Pinot Grigio Blush wine from Northern Veneto. Delicate and thirst quenching with aromas of strawberry, raspberry and citrus. Very floral and fresh, and some mineral notes..

Campo de Luz Garnacha Rosado - Tierra de Castilla, Spain *VE* 26

A fruity red wine expressing the characteristic liquorice flavours of Tempranillo. Unoaked, it shows bright cherry and red fruits with a soft, long finish. A fantastic Spanish red, by small family producer Vallemayor.
